



Bus Travel Guidelines & Conduct

1. The use of personal entertainment equipment without headphones is prohibited.
2. Cell phones should be set to vibrate and any conversations should be kept short and quiet.
3. It is the responsibility of all Club trip participants to be present at the time and place appointed for trip departure.
4. All participants must remain on the bus until the trip leader returns with the lift tickets.
5. Each trip participant is asked to sit in the same seat to and from the resort.
6. If any participant makes a non-bus arrangement for transportation to or from the resort, the trip leader must receive prior notification.
7. No movies shall be shown on bus equipment on any trips.
8. The use of illegal drugs or the abuse of alcohol is prohibited.
9. All skis and snowboards must be enclosed in protective bags for transport on buses in under-bus compartments.
10. Code of Conduct
 - a. Members should treat each other with mutual respect. Behavior and/or communication by a member that by its nature could be considered threatening, harassing, or abusive to other members or guests will not be tolerated.
 - b.
