Itinerary

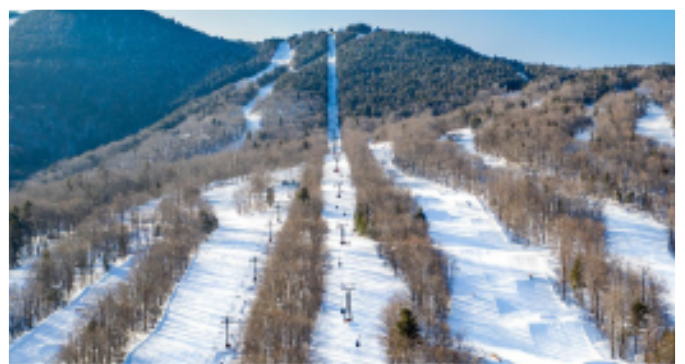
